We also love the Italian-made vintage fedoras that sell for around \$40.

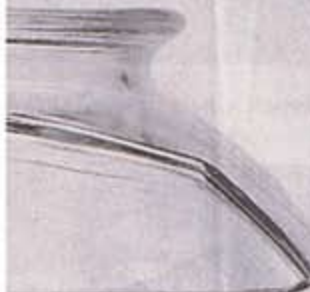

## CARE FOR IT

### A goldfish survival guide

Goldfish originated in China around the year 1000, a natural mutation of the Crucian carp. They were exported to Japan around 1500 and recently Japanese animator/writer/director Hayao Miyazaki has transported them to the big screen, in *Ponyo*, an animated feature adaptation of Hans Christian Andersen's *The Little Mermaid*.

While no one can help you transform the goldfish in your tank into a human, PJ's Pets vice-president Brad Hamilton has these tips to ensure your fish lives a long and healthy life.

- Never overfeed your fish. Goldfish lack a true stomach. In the wild, they eat plants and small insects. In captivity, they eat flakes or pellet food, chopped mosquito larvae and cereal.
- Don't keep goldfish in small bowls. They need higher oxygen

levels than a narrow-top bowl will allow and ideally should be kept in a filtered aquarium. Ratios should be: 1 gallon of water for 1 goldfish; 5 gallons for 2 to 3; 10 gallons for 3 to 4; 20 gallons for 6 to 8; 30 gallons for 9 to 12.

• Change the water regularly but do not change 100 per cent of it, because that removes the healthy bacteria. For a smaller tank, change 25 to 30 per cent of the water once or twice a week. Add water conditioner, which removes chemicals from tap water, and let it sit overnight. Bigger tanks require fewer water changes and are less work than smaller tanks.

• Keep water temperatures moderate, between 17C and 22C.

• Goldfish live between five and 10 years. The oldest goldfish, according to the *Guinness Book of Records*, lived for 43 years.
